New Volunteer Lawyers and Accountants for the Arts (VLAA) Referral Guidelines

To serve more nonprofit arts and cultural organizations, VLAA changed their referral guidelines: Going forward, organizations with annual budgets under \$1 million now qualify for free assistance — that's up from \$500,000.
